



EQUESTRIAN CAMPS SOUTH WEST - CAMP CODE

- All gates to the yard and the camping field must be kept shut at all times.
- Pick up any droppings from the areas surrounding the stables and the tracks.
- Give each other space when mounting.
- No rider is allowed on the XC course without a current standard body protector and skull cap on without a fixed peak OR without an instructor present.
- Visitors to camp may attend by prior arrangement 3 days before the camp, so that we can add them to the insurance please and also because having lots of people watching the lessons can be distracting for the riders, so we like to keep them to a minimum. If visitors wish to stay overnight there is a charge to cover meals. Absolutely no under-fives allowed on to the cross-country course or in and around the stables.
- Visitors are welcome to help yourselves to beverages and we will be happy to squeeze you into the cafeteria if you bring a chair and are willing to pay a charge for all meals.
- 'Teaching' from spectators is absolutely forbidden. If this happens you may be asked to leave. You will be asked to be quiet.
- Please remember that your first lesson is an assessment and that occasionally one horse and rider may need more attention to help them get the most out of camp. We've all been there and appreciated an instructor taking that time, please be patient and considerate. And remember, you and your group can become a great team! Often this is where the seeds of friendship are planted too.
- Our instructors are hand-picked, highly experienced and I trust them implicitly. Please try to understand that they will always have the best interests of the horses and riders at the forefront of their mind. And they are approachable! If you wish to do something that your instructor hasn't suggested, please speak to your instructor at the end of the lesson or the camp organisers, they're not mind readers and they can't make it happen after the event.
- Under 18's Must be placed/paired with an adult who accepts full responsibility for them as nominated by the parent.
- All stables are allocated, please don't swap and change. They must be left clean with the remaining straw banked up at the rear of the stable. Anyone who leaves their stable dirty will be asked to pay £10.00.
- Please respect the venue, keep it clean, tidy and undamaged so that we will be welcome back.
- Most importantly, look after each other, look out for each other and have FUN!
